	net worth of less than \$250,000, excluding the value of the business and primary
	residence. 8(a) firms automatically quality for Small Disadvantaged Business
	certification.
<u>Disabled-Owner</u>	At least 51% owned by handicapped persons who exercise the power to make
<u>Business</u>	policy decisions and who are actively involved in the day-to-day management of
	the business. A handicapped person has a physical or mental impairment that
	substantially limits one or more major life activities, has a record of such
	impairment, or is regarded as having such impairment.
